As someone who recognizes he could not have traveled as far as he has without the support, encouragement, and advice from his many mentors, Andy took great pride in establishing informal student workshops.

Benavides' mentorship program allows young artists to develop their areas of creative interest and demonstrates how to market their creations in a real world setting. In 2005 he and his wife established S.M.A.R.T. (Supporting Multiple Arts Together) a not for profit organization that is dedicated to raising awareness of the developmental impact of the arts on our city. Building communities through the arts. His diverse interests are balanced through his continued passion for the arts. As an active contemporary artist, he utilizes his sincere exploration of his mediums with experiential concern.
